The program consists of a postgraduate course at the School of Music of Fiesole, Florence, and an intensive course of Italian language and culture, in the framework of Rondine's residential training in multicultural dialogue and conflict resolution in the Tuscan countryside.

In a medieval village near Arezzo (Tuscany), young students from areas of conflict or with different cultures of the Balkans, Caucasus, Middle-East and Africa, live together and experiment a shared academic education and training experience.

Scuola di Musica di Fiesole

For nearly forty years, the Scuola di Musica di Fiesole has served as a benchmark for music worldwide. Founded by Piero Farulli, legendary violist of the Quartetto Italiano, the School today has 1,300 students, 7 orchestras, 6 choirs and 140 teachers. It is active 350 days a year with 280 public events held annually. Hundreds of musicians who studied here are working professionally; of those who were members of the Orchestra Giovanile Italiana, the School's national pre-professional symphonic ensemble, there are 1,017 to date.
