

VOLDA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE IN NORWAY OFFERS 3 QUOTA FOR STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF PRISHTINA "HASAN PRISHTINA".

Volda University College in Norway offers 3 quota for students of the University of Prishtina "Hasan Prishtina". Student must have completed at least one year in University of Prishtina before starting studies in Volda. Initially the students will start with one year of Norwegian course and then either a bachelor (for example in social work, music, outdoor life, art or journalism etc.) for 3 years or less depending on the bachelor or a master.

NORWEGIAN LANGUAGE AND CIVILIZATION FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

This one-year course aims to give students the knowledge and skills necessary for studies at Norwegian colleges and universities. The emphasis is on giving students good general proficiency in the Norwegian language. The course also aims to help students adapt to the Norwegian society.

The main target group is students arriving in Norway as part of bi- and multilateral programmes. Students under the [Quota scheme programme](#) are given priority, whether students apply to Volda University College or to other Norwegian university colleges. The course is on undergraduate level and gives 60 ECTS-credits.

English is used as an explanatory tool in the beginning of the course, but as students increase their Norwegian proficiency they will be required to use this exclusively.
